## GENERAL REFUND POLICY:

- If you notify us in writing at least 3 weeks prior to the beginning of program that you will be unable to attend, we will refund all your payment, minus a \$10 administrative fee.
- No refunds will be issued upon expulsion, voluntary withdrawal, or less than three weeks prior to the start of program, except for a medical emergency of which a Doctor's note would be required for verification.

## COVID REFUND POLICY:

Due to the uncertainty with COVID-19, the PARSIPPANY PAL would like to provide its families with the following clarification and guidance of the upcoming season's refund policy.

- Prior to the start of the program, if a player withdraws from a registered program or requests a refund, a refund will be processed upon request less a \$10 processing fee. No refunds will be issued upon voluntary withdrawal, or less than three weeks prior to the start of program (1<sup>st</sup> game), except for a medical emergency of which a Doctor's note would be required for verification.
- If one or more state/local governing bodies provide guidance to restrict the ability to conduct sessions resulting in the cancellation of the PAL-hosted program prior to the start of the season, all players who are currently registered will receive a full refund for the cancelled sessions.
- If the PAL-hosted program starts but is unable to finish due to one or more state/local governing bodies restricting the ability to conduct the sessions, PAL will offer a pro-rated refund less a modest fee to offset nonrefundable program costs. Our goal is to provide the best basketball experience for our families. These "goals" come with some fixed costs to run our programs, regardless of the number of registered players.
- Given the PAL status as a non-profit organization for the benefit of the youth of Parsippany, the PAL would greatly appreciate any potential future refund of fees being converted to PAL donations, at the sole discretion of each family. We appreciate our community's ongoing support during these unprecedented times.
